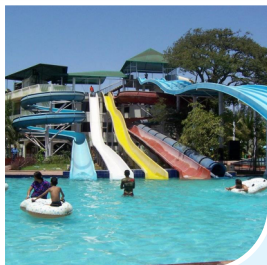

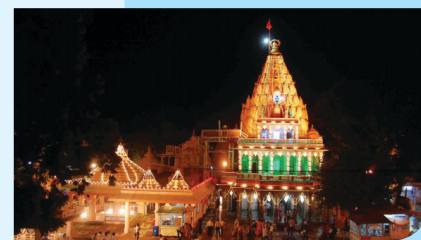
About Indore

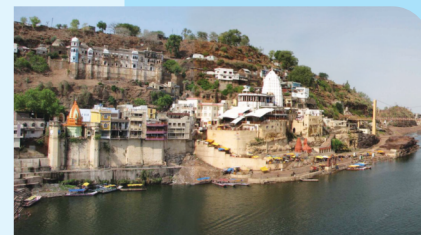
